Exegesis Help

It can be difficult to research for an exegesis, considering many books may be checked out or in use. Benner Library offers several resources helpful for finding electronic sources to avoid that situation.

Navigation

Step 1: Begin on Benner Library Home page, library.olivet.edu.Step 2: Under the Subject Guides tab, click on Theology.Step 3: Navigate to the Ministry Matters database, found under Selected eBooks.



Ministry Matters

This database houses many eBooks that are also found at Benner Library. If a physical copy of the book is unavailable and the professor approves, the eBook can be used instead.

Using Ministry Matters

Note: From the Ministry Matters page on the Benner Library site, you will notice that there are two links on the left side of the page. It is recommended that both are tried.



Step 1: Under the Browse tab, click on Biblical Commentaries and then on a specific commentary. Use the Table of Contents on the right side of the page to clarify between volume number and Biblical book.

Step 2: Once in Atla, click on Scriptures at the top of the screen.

Step 4: If looking for a series of verses, click on the appropriate chapter and the database will search accordingly. If looking for a specific verse, click Expand next to the chapter and click on the appropriate verse.
