
Access Instructions

- 1. <u>Library.olivet.edu</u>

- 4. Under "Selected eBooks" click on Anchor Yale Bible Commentary (database)
- 5. Log-in with ONU credentials if prompted.
- 6. From the Anchor Yale Bible Commentaries landing page scroll down to "Explore the commentaries" Use + sign to expand Old Testament or New Testament.
- 7. Click on the desired text. Some books of the Bible are divided into more than one volume, so check chapters, too. Notes: Matthew not available online | Roman numerals list
- 8. When the volume's landing page opens
 - Gather necessary info for your citation: author, publication date, volume title
 - b. Consider using the tools in the upper right corner from any page in the database:



- i. Save: Create a free account to save books and chapters.
- ii. **Print**: Generate a .pdf of the page you're viewing. Save or print it.
- iii. **Share**: Send yourself (or someone else) a citation for the page you're viewing. Includes clickable DOI (link).
- iv. **Citation**: Choose from APA, MLA, Chicago. Double-check citation format with a reliable source.
- 9. Scroll down to interactive Table of Contents.
 - a. Click on desired section.
 - b. Make a note of the page numbers for your citations.







10. Use "breadcrumbs" at top of page to navigate to a different volume or section.
