Access Instructions

1. Library.olivet.edu
2. Subject Guides
3. Biblical Literature
4. Under “Selected eBooks” click on [MinistryMatters](#) (database)
5. From the MinistryMatters landing page created by Benner Library, click the direct link for *Abingdon New Testament Commentary*. Log-in with ONU credentials if prompted.
6. Confirm the selections on the drop-down menus at the top of the page:

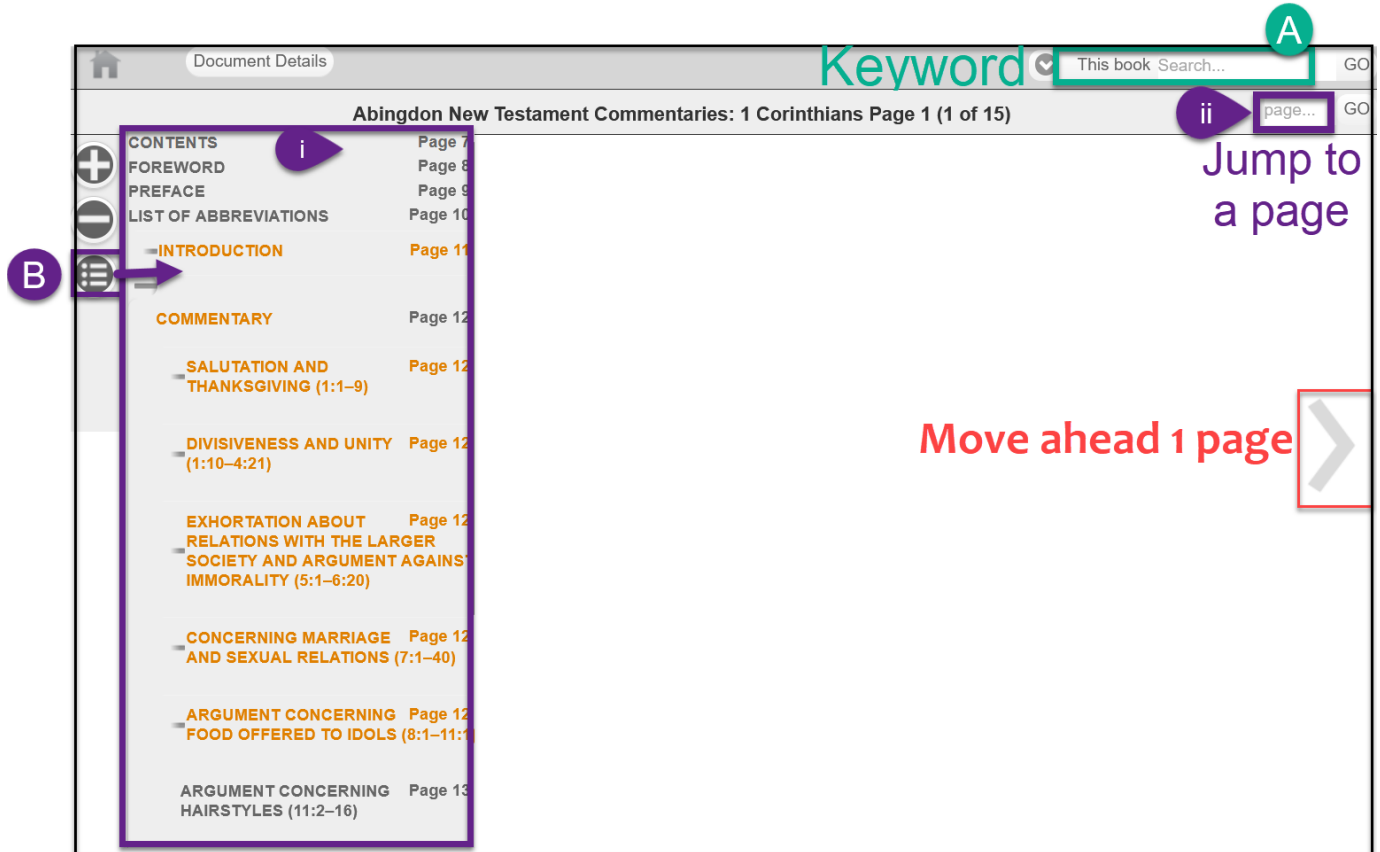

7. Scroll to the volume which contains your passage, then click “**Read Now.**” Note: volumes are listed in alpha-numeric order, not canonical order (New Testament volumes followed by Old Testament volumes). **Note: Luke not (yet) available!!**
8. When the volume’s landing page opens
 - a. Gather necessary info for your citation: author, publication date, volume title
 - b. PREFERRED METHOD: Click on the orange **Read online** button OR
 - c. Scroll down to type in “Search withing this book” box
9. To navigate the digital version of this commentary choose a method; see screenshot below:
 - a. Type a keyword into the search box (upper right) and click “GO”

- b. **PREFERRED METHOD:** Open Table of Contents using the icon on the left side of the page.
- Scroll until you find the desired section
 - Type the page number into the “page” box (upper right) and click “GO”
